## Person of Ancient Athens Info

Number:  Enter a 6-digit number to uniquely identify a person from Ancient Athens or upto 6 digit to specify a range of numbers: e.g., typing '306...' in the Num field  
limits the search to all persons between 306000 (DHMAGAQH) and 306997 (DHMHTRIA)

Name:  NOT  Enter in capital letters in Greek transliteration(e.g., BIQUS, DECIOS). C=ksi, F=phi, H=eta, Q=theta, U=upsilon, W=omega, Y=psi.

PA or Roman Name:  NOT  Enter in capital letters in Greek transliteration. Enter as digits only for PA number(Citation in Kirchner),  
or **S** for Sundwall and **D** for Davies.

Status:  A = Athenian citizen, R = Roman, NA = non-Athenian (foreigner), F/N = freed or naturalized, S = slave, M = metic, ? = doubtful  
\*A.\*R\* means both Athenian and Roman citizen, etc {A} means only Athenian citizen

Place:  Enter in capital letters in Greek transliteration for demotic or ethnic of a person

Phyle:  Choose the phylai from the pull down menu

Link:  Select a relationship from the pull down menu

Kin's Name:  NOT  Enter in capital letters in Greek transliteration(e.g., BIQUS, DECIOS)

## ID Info

Activity:  Please select common abbreviations

Date:  Enter using conventional dating formulas (e.g., c Ip = around the first century AD)

Date From:  To:  Enter using numbers and "-" for BC dates (e.g., From: -200 To: 100).
